

How To Determine Your IBC Valve Thread

IBC tanks can have a few different types of fittings.

The most common is the IBC threads or Buttress threads, its a larger courser thread and come in a few sizes but your IBC tank could also have a BSP thread or a DIN thread.

Follow the guide below to find the correct thread on your IBC tank.

Step 1

Carefully measure the outside diameter of the IBC opening.

Step 2

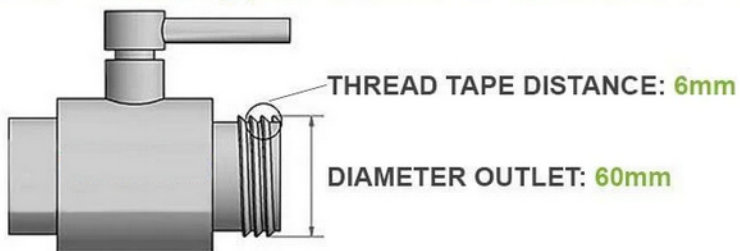
Accurately measure the distance between the thread from peak to peak.

Step 3

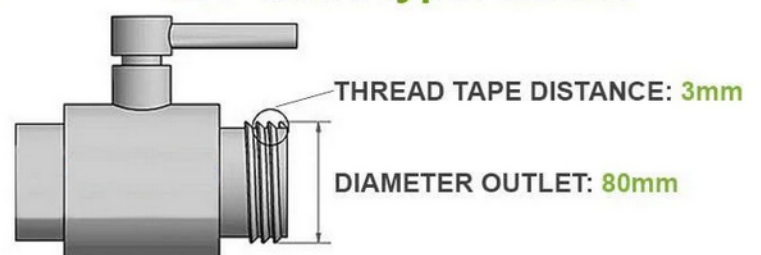
View the threads below to see what size you have.



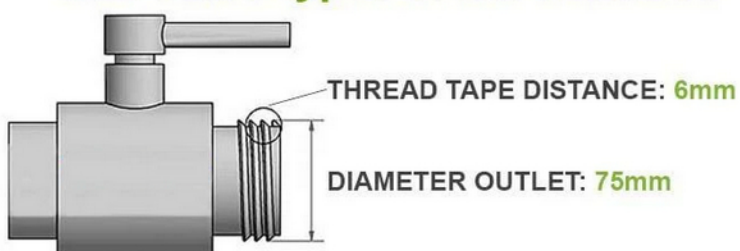
IBC Valve type: S60x6 Buttress / DN50
